A Moroccan hammam is a traditional bathing ritual that involves entering a steam room, being scrubbed down by an attendant with a kessa mitt and black beldi soap to slough off dead skin, followed by a cold rinse, and ending with more time in the steam room. Many follow this with an intense massage to complete the relaxation, often incorporating argan oil, orange blossom water, or a rhassoul clay wrap to leave you with soft, glowing skin.

If hammams aren't quite your thing, you will find many more luxury treatments to indulge in to make you feel pampered and relaxed. Custom-blended skin treatments, private jacuzzis, facials, hair treatments, and hand and foot treatments can be found in stunningly beautiful settings. You can also visit a spa at most luxury properties, even if you are not staying on site.







1. Arrive in Casablanca on an overnight flight and meet your personal driver. Visit the stunning Hassan II Mosque, the largest in Morocco. Continue on to Rabat, where you will see the Hassan Tower and the Mohammed V Mausoleum. Overnight in Rabat.
2. After a leisurely morning, depart Rabat to travel north to Tangier. Enjoy the afternoon exploring the medina, or relaxing in your hotel looking out over the Mediterranean Sea. Overnight in Tangier.
3. Visit Cap Spartel and the legendary Cave of Hercules in the morning, before heading to Asilah to spend the afternoon in the white-washed medina that has become a hub for artists. Overnight in Tangier.
4. Travel to Chefchaouen, nestled high in the Rif Mountains. Spend the afternoon exploring the blue-washed medina. Overnight in Chefchaouen.
