

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Wanderlust Voyages PTANA Moroccan FAM Tour

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (YOU) acknowledges that Wanderlust Voyages, LLC is acting as an independent intermediary (Travel Agent) between YOU and SUPPLIERS of goods and services which are not directly supplied by Wanderlust Voyages, LLC, such as air transportation, hotel, accommodation, ground and sea transportation, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc., and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Wanderlust Voyages and any organization contracting its services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages, or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, disease, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities, or any other actions, omissions, or conditions outside their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler voluntarily assumes all the risks. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above, and engaging Wanderlust Voyages acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold Wanderlust Voyages blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers.

REGISTRATION

Deposit of \$300 and completion of the Agent Form are required to hold your spot. Registrants will be verified to be members in good standing with PTANA. Registration will be done via the Wanderlust Voyages website at www.wanderlustvoyagestravel.com/ptana. Deposits are non-refundable. You are strongly encouraged to purchase travel insurance to cover the trip.

PRICE

All prices are shown in U.S. Dollars and are calculated on currency rates and fares. Wanderlust Voyages reserves the right to alter prices at any time prior to departure and without prior notice if circumstances so warrant. Any devaluation or revaluation of currencies may affect the published price.

FINAL PAYMENT

Final payment will be made via invoice, and must be paid no later than January 15, 2019.

NOT INCLUDED

Items of a personal nature, such as telephone calls, mini bar, laundry, food or beverages outside of noted meals, alcohol, spa services, or optional activities are not included. These extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, restaurant, or service provider. Please see the details of each specific tour for a full list of what is included/excluded on that tour.

PASSPORTS, VISAS, & DOCUMENTS

A valid US passport is required for all US citizens. Passports must be valid for at least six months from the date of departure. If you do not have a valid passport, please contact your closest passport office. US or Canadian citizens do not need to obtain visas for Morocco. For all other nationalities, please consult the country's consulate. When and if a visa is required, it is the traveler's responsibility to obtain one. Cancellations due to lack of appropriate documents will incur usual penalties. A copy of the passport must be provided to Wanderlust Voyages within 2 weeks of booking.

FINAL DOCUMENTS

Final documents are issued no later than within 2 weeks of departure. Upon receipt of your documents you are responsible to check your itinerary, the spelling of your name, dates, time and other important information to ensure their validity. Should your final documents have any errors, it is the passenger's responsibility to contact Wanderlust Voyages immediately.

PARTICIPATION

Wanderlust Voyages and suppliers contracted for services reserve the right to refuse to accept or retain any person whose behavior is deemed likely to affect the smooth operations of a tour or adversely affect the enjoyment or safety of other passengers. Wanderlust Voyages, its agents, and suppliers shall be under no liability to any such person for refund, compensation, repatriation, or other any matter arising.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

Once a payment has been made, payment is non-refundable. You are strongly encouraged to purchase travel insurance. If you wish to cancel your trip, you must provide notice of cancellation in writing to info@wanderlustvoyagetravel.com. No changes of names or substitutions are permitted. No refund or cancellation fees will be waived due to death or sickness.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

You are encouraged to purchase travel insurance for your travel investment. Wanderlust Voyages is able provide travel insurance upon request.

AIR TRANSPORTATION

Air transportation is in economy class on IATA-approved carriers. Ticketing must be completed no later than 14 days prior to departure. Fares are based on levels in effect at the time of printing and prices and schedules are subject to change without notice. All are subject to the airline's terms of carriage. Wanderlust Voyages is not responsible for any cancellations, loss, delays, injury, illness, or expenses incurred due to actions made by the airlines. Business class is available at additional cost. For any issues which arise in relation to airline service complaints and compensation should be addressed to the specific carrier.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT

Random seats are assigned for all group participants. If you would like to secure a specific seat or sit with a companion, please advise us of such request at the time of booking, and we will make an effort to accommodate you, although we cannot guarantee that such seating will be available. Seats are at the discretion of the airline and seats are pending availability, subject to aircraft/seat map changes.

MEALS

The FAM trip will include three meals per day, which are served at your hotel or local restaurants that have been pre-booked. In case you choose not to have a meal, there is no refund for unused meals. We will try to accommodate all special meal requests on flights and hotels if you advise us of any such requests at the time of the booking. We cannot guarantee that all special meal/dietary requests can be met.

BAGGAGE

Each traveler is permitted to bring one checked suitcase, weighing no more than 50lbs, one small carry on bag (8" x 14" x 22"), and one personal item (e.g., purse, laptop, etc.). Travelers are responsible for any additional baggage fees for excess, overweight, or oversized baggage. Wanderlust Voyages is not responsible for the loss of, theft of, delay, or damage to a participant's belongings.

RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSE

Wanderlust Voyages acts as a Tour Manager. The suppliers providing transportation, sightseeing arrangements, and hotel accommodations for the tour program are independent contractors and are not agents or employees of Wanderlust Voyages. All coupons, receipts, and tickets issued are subject to the terms and conditions specified by the suppliers. By utilizing the services of the suppliers, you agree that Wanderlust Voyages will not be liable for any change in flight or itinerary schedule, strikes, delay, acts of governments, fires, riots, theft, pilferage, epidemics, quarantine, medical or customs regulations, accident, loss, injury, or damage to you or those traveling with you in connection to any accommodations, transportation, or other services, or resulting directly or indirectly from any occurrence or conditions beyond its control, including defects in vehicles, breakdown in equipment, thefts, delay, or cancellation of or changes in itinerary for any act, omission or event during the time you on board the aircraft. Neither Wanderlust Voyages and/or agents of the airlines concerned are to be held responsible for the late arrival of passengers at airports or hotels due to inclement weather, nor are they to be held liable for payment or any refund for transfers or unused hotel accommodations or meals occasioned by such late arrivals at the hotels holding rooms as confirmed itineraries. Passengers must bear all such losses or expenses. In circumstances where trip cancellations resulting from the inability for the trip to depart as scheduled, such as cancellations due to acts of war, terrorism, or nature takes place, Wanderlust Voyages is not liable for restitution. TOUR CANCELLATION BY OPERATOR

Be advised that from time to time a tour departure may be canceled due to lack of participation. In such cases, the operator's sole responsibility is to provide a full refund.
